County of Devon _____ was, on the twelfth ___ day of January ___ in the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and thirty seven, confirmed by the Tithe County of Devon ____ was, on the twelfth ___ day of January ___ in the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and thirty seven, confirmed by the Tithe Commissioners for England and Wales, of which Agreement, with the Schedule thereunto annexed, the following is a Copy :- excepting only acertain statement in the said Agreement of all the Titheable Lands of the said Parish with the Names of the respective Owners thereof and the proportional Sums at which such Sunds respectively are rated to the Poor and which Statement is in the said Copy omitted ______

Articles of Agreement for the Commutation of the Sithes of the Parish of Burlescombe in the County of Devon in pursuance of the act for the Commutation of the Tithes in England and Wales made and executed at a Meeting duly called and holden at the Vestry Room in the said Parish and by adjournment at the Vicarage House in the said Parish on the twelfth day of November in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty six according to the provisions of the said act By and Between the several Bodies Politic and Sersons Owners of Land within the said Parish by whom or by whose agents duly authorised in that behalf these presents are executed and the interest of which Landowners in the Lands of the said Parish is not less than two thirds of the Lands therein subject to Tithes of the one part, Edward ayshford Sanford Esquire Owner of the Impropriate or Great Tithes of the said Parish (except the Impropriate or Great Tithes of Great Bochill otherwise Buhill Farm and of certain Lands called ayshford Sando in the said Parish the Great Tithes whereof belong to Vincent Stuckey Esquire as Improprie aton thereof and which said interest of the said Edward ayshford Sunford is more than two thirds of all the Impropriate or Great Tithes of the suid Parish and The Reverend Thomas Tanner blerk Vicar of the said Parish and Owner of the Vicarial and Small Tithes thereof (except the Vicarial and Imall Tithes of the said Farm and Sands called Great Bochill otherwise Buhill Farm and ayshford Lands the Vicarial and Imall Tithes whereof belong to The Reverend Sydney Smith Clerk as Vicar of the Parish of Halberton in the said bounty) and which said interest of the said Thomas Tanner Clerk is more than two thirds of all the Vicarial and Imall Tithes of the

And that the annual sum of Fifteen Sounds by way of Rentcharge (subject to variation as in the said act provided and subject to the other provisions therein contained) shall be payable and paid to the said Vincent Stuckey and "his Successors and Afrigno instead of the Impropriate or Great Tithes of the said Farm and Sands called Great Boehill otherwise Buhill Farm and Aryshford Lands and all Moderses and Compositions real and prescriptive and customary payments payable in respect of such Sands or the produce thereof

And that the annual sum of Three hundred and thirty Bounds by way of Rent-charge (subject to variation as in the said Act provided and subject to other provisions therein contained) shall be payable and paid to the said Thomas Janner as Vicar of the said Parish and to his Successors instead of the Vicarial and Imall Titles of the portion of the Lands of the said Parish the Vicarial and Imall Titles whereof belong to the said Thomas Tanner (except the Vicarial Titles of the Glebe of the said portion of the said Parish a Rent charge instead of the Titles whereof is hereinafter specially provided) and all Moduses and Compositions real and prescriptive and customary payments payable in respect of such Lands or the produce thereof

And that the annual Sum of Twelve Sounds by way of Resit-charge (subject to variation as in the said act provided and subject to other provisions therein contained, shall be payable and paid to the said Sydney Smith as Vicar of the said Parish of Halberton and to his Successors instead of the Vicarial
