APPORTIONMENT of the RENT-CHARGE in lieu of TITHES in the Parish of Burlescombe  
in the County of Devon

*Pl. N/S.*

**W**hereas an Agreement for the COMMUTATION of TITHES in the Parish of Burlescombe in the County of Devon was, on the twelfth day of January in the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and thirty seven, confirmed by the Tithe Commissioners for England and Wales, of which Agreement, with the Schedule thereunto annexed, the following is a Copy:— *excepting only a certain statement in the said Agreement of all the Titheable Lands of the said Parish with the Names of the respective Owners thereof and the proportional Sums at which such Lands respectively are rated to the Poor and which Statement is in the said Copy omitted*

*Articles of Agreement for the Commutation of the Tithes of the Parish of Burlescombe in the County of Devon in pursuance of the Act for the Commutation of the Tithes in England and Wales made and executed at a Meeting duly called and holden at the Vestry Room in the said Parish and by adjournment at the Vicarage House in the said Parish on the twelfth day of November in the Year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty six according to the provisions of the said Act By and Between the several Bodies Politic and Persons Owners of Land within the said Parish by whom or by whose Agents duly authorised in that behalf these presents are executed and the interest of which Landowners in the Lands of the said Parish is not less than two thirds of the Lands therein subject to Tithes of the one part, Edward Aynshford Sanford Esquire Owner of the Improprate or Great Tithes of the said Parish (except the Improprate or Great Tithes of Great Boehill otherwise Buhill Farm and of certain Lands called Aynshford Lands in the said Parish the Great Tithes whereof belong to Vincent Stuckey Esquire as Improprator thereof and which said interest of the said Edward Aynshford Sanford is more than two thirds of all the Improprate or Great Tithes of the said Parish and The Reverend Thomas Tanner Clerk Vicar of the said Parish and Owner of the Vicarial and Small Tithes thereof (except the Vicarial and Small Tithes of the said Farm and Lands called Great Boehill otherwise Buhill Farm and Aynshford Lands the Vicarial and Small Tithes whereof belong to The Reverend Sydney Smith Clerk as Vicar of the Parish of Halberton in the said County) and which said interest of the said Thomas Tanner Clerk is more than two thirds of all the Vicarial and Small Tithes of the*



said Parish of Burlescombe of the other part

It is by these presents witnessed that at the said Meeting it hath been and is mutually agreed <sup>upon</sup> by and between all the said parties to these presents in manner following that is to say that the annual sum of Two hundred and twenty Pounds by way of Rent-charge (subject to variation as in the said Act provided and subject to the other provisions therein contained) shall be payable and paid to the said Edward Aysford Sanford his Heirs and Assigns instead of the Improprate or Great Tithes of the portion of the Lands of the said Parish the Improprate or Great Tithes whereof belong to the said Edward Aysford Sanford and all Moduses and Compositions real and prescriptive and customary payments payable in respect of such Lands or the produce thereof

And that the annual sum of Fifteen Pounds by way of Rent-charge (subject to variation as in the said Act provided and subject to the other provisions therein contained) shall be payable and paid to the said Vincent Stuckey and his Successors and Assigns instead of the Improprate or Great Tithes of the said Farm and Lands called Great Boehill otherwise Buhill Farm and Aysford Lands and all Moduses and Compositions real and prescriptive and customary payments payable in respect of such Lands or the produce thereof

And that the annual sum of Three hundred and thirty Pounds by way of Rent-charge (subject to variation as in the said Act provided and subject to other provisions therein contained) shall be payable and paid to the said Thomas Tanner as Vicar of the said Parish and to his Successors instead of the Vicarial and Small Tithes of the portion of the Lands of the said Parish the Vicarial and Small Tithes whereof belong to the said Thomas Tanner (except the Vicarial Tithes of the Glebe of the said portion of the said Parish a Rent-charge instead of the Tithes whereof is hereinafter specially provided) and all Moduses and Compositions real and prescriptive and customary payments payable in respect of such Lands or the produce thereof

And that the annual Sum of Twelve Pounds by way of Rent-charge (subject to variation as in the said Act provided and subject to other provisions therein contained) shall be payable and paid to the said Sydney Smith as Vicar of the said Parish of Halberton and to his Successors instead of the Vicarial



and Small Tithes of the said Farm and Lands called Great Boehill otherwise Bohill Farm and  
Aynford Lands and all Moduses and Compositions real and prescriptive and customary payments  
payable in respect of such Lands or the produce thereof

And it is hereby agreed that the <sup>annual</sup> sum of One Pound shall be paid to the  
said Thomas Tanner Clerk as Vicar of the said Parish and to his Successors in the said Vicarage  
by way of Rent-charge instead of the Vicarial Tithes of the Glebe Lands within the said Portion  
of the said Parish whenever the said Glebe shall not be in the occupation of the Owner thereof and  
that the said sum of One Pound shall be apportioned upon the said Glebe Lands exclusively

The whole Parish of Burliscombe aforesaid contains by estimation  
Three thousand four hundred and forty two Acres three Roods and ten Perches of Land  
statute measure

The whole quantity of the Lands of the said Parish which are subject  
to the payment of any kind of Tithes is by estimation Two thousand seven hundred and sixty  
seven Acres two Roods and ten Perches statute measure

The whole quantity of Land subject to Tithes within the said  
Parish which is cultivated as Arable Land is by estimation One thousand four hundred and  
fifty five Acres and thirty three Perches statute measure

The whole quantity of Land subject to Tithes within the said Parish  
cultivated as Meadow or Pasture Land is by estimation One thousand one hundred and  
seventy eight Acres two Roods and seventeen Perches statute measure including Orchards  
and Gardens

The whole quantity of Land subject to Tithes in the said Parish  
now cultivated as Woodland and Plantation is by estimation One hundred and thirty  
three Acres and three Roods statute measure

The undermentioned Moduses or Compositions real or prescriptive  
or customary payments are payable instead of the undermentioned Tithes of the said  
Parish and the undermentioned Lands and Tithes respectively are covered thereby that is to say



The Sum of twenty shillings due annually at Lady day has been paid to the Vicar of the said Parish in lieu of Vicarial Tithes in respect of Great Southdown Farm belonging to D<sup>r</sup>. Metford containing One hundred and fifty five Acres estimated statute measure. There is no evidence that Great Tithes have ever been rendered or paid in respect of the said Farm.

The Sum of Twelve pounds eleven shillings and one penny <sup>due annually</sup> at Midsummer is paid to the Vicar of the said Parish as a composition or Rent charge in lieu of the Vicarial Tithes of Forty nine Acres of Land taken to the Grand Western Canal as prescribed by an Act of the 36 George 3<sup>d</sup>.

The undermentioned Lands of the said Parish are and have been under the undermentioned circumstances exempt from the payment of Tithes (that is to say)

A Tenement at Rockland Green consisting of a House Garden and two Orchards containing One Acre and one Rood estimated statute measure belonging to Elizabeth Atton.

Canonsleigh containing Seventy three Acres and three roods estimated statute measure belonging to Thomas Brown Esq<sup>r</sup>.

The <sup>estimated</sup> Barton of Canonsleigh containing One hundred and ninety six Acres and two Roods statute measure belonging to Thomas Brown Esq<sup>r</sup>.

Rockland Farm containing One hundred and twenty four Acres estimated statute measure belonging to Richard Marker Esq<sup>r</sup>.

Huntland containing Twenty Acres estimated statute measure belonging to the Representatives of the late Mrs. Pugh.

Lower Eastbrook containing Forty eight Acres and three Roods estimated statute measure belonging to Thomas Brown Esq<sup>r</sup>.

Crimms Close and Crimms Meadow containing Seven Acres estimated statute measure belonging to Humphrey Langley Esq<sup>r</sup>.
